Fourth Report of the Referee – DD12236/Krasinski

The author has made extensive modifications to the paper that make it suitable for publication. I recommend that it is published without further delay, once the author has considered a single minor comment:

(1) Many of the numerical values throughout the text are quoted to a very large number of significant figures, especially in Section 8. It is unlikely that this level of accuracy is needed numerically. Please reduce the number of significant figures for all of the numbers quoted throughout the text; between 4 - 6 s.f. would be appropriate. If the large number of significant figures is actually needed for the numerics however, then this is an important detail that must be commented on in the text.
